Advice and support for a client who wanted to implement an ISO standard within their premises

#Challenge

A world-leading French company in the manufacturing of generator sets wanted to be able to conduct tests at its laboratory to obtain the certification for international standard ISO/IEC 17025 in order to expand into International Markets.

ISO/IEC 17025 - defines the general and technical requirements for calibration and testing laboratory competence - had never been implemented by this laboratory before. Trescal, who had already managed the calibration of their measuring instruments was consulted to **support the Laboratory** as they brought their tests into line with the standard's requirements and as part of their preparations for the COFRAC audit, COFRAC being the national body responsible for accrediting laboratories in accordance with the ISO/IEC 17025.
